Working with straw braid

Working with Laichow straw braid (also known as pedal straw) learn how to make small hat shapes suitable for percher or tilt hats, on a domestic sewing machine.

Traditionally, straw braid hats are made on specialised machines, but this class will show you the scope of what is possible on a normal domestic sewing machine. You will learn:

- How to correctly handle and work the straw braid
- How to make the 'button' to start the hat (and how to determine what shape to make it)
- Blocking the straw shape, and
- How to get a professional looking edge on your brim

It is essential that students are confident on a sewing machine!



Day One:

Make a straw braid button shape, suitable for a percher or cocktail hat, or make a straw braid boater crown.

Day Two:

Make a straw braid brim to go with the boater crown made on day one, including how to get a professionally finished edge on your brim.
